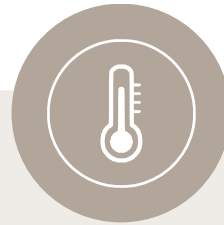

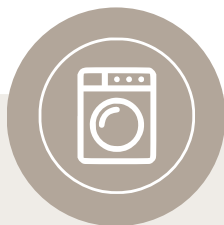

COLCHESTER POND

Check out this 3.0-mile loop trail near Colchester, Vermont. Generally considered an easy route, it takes an average of 1 h 11 min to complete. This is a very popular area for hiking and trail running, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring. The best times to visit this trail are April through October. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash.



BAYSIDE PARK & PLAYGROUND

The park is 22-acres overlooking the naturally beautiful Malletts Bay area of Lake Champlain, including beach access, and with a rugged forest area located at Upper Bayside. This park is walking distance from the house.



SHELBURNE MUSEUM

Shelburne Museum is one of the most popular attractions in Vermont. Shelburne Museum is the largest art and history museum in northern New England and a foremost public resource for visual art and material culture.



BURLINGTON FARMERS MARKET

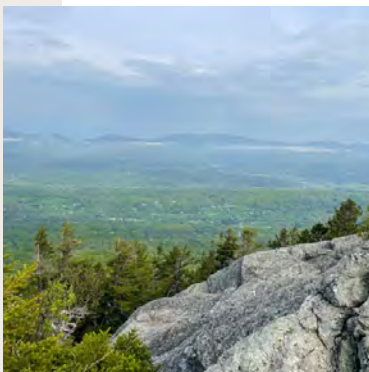
CAMEL'S HUMP TRAIL

Camel's Hump Trail is one of the best day hiking trails in the Green Mountain National Forest, along with being the third highest peak in the state. The summit offers unbeatable views in every direction, including Killington Peak. The trailhead can be accessed off of Camel's Hump Road, where there is a small parking area for visitors.



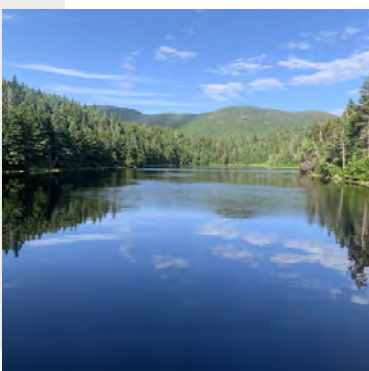
MOUNT MANSFIELD LOOP TRAIL

Enjoy this 3.7-mile out-and-back trail near Stowe, Vermont. Generally considered a challenging route, it takes an average of 2 h 45 min to complete. This is a very popular area for birding and hiking, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring.



STERLING POND TRAIL

Experience this 2.3-mile out-and-back trail near Jeffersonville, Vermont. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 1 h 38 min to complete. This is a very popular area for hiking and walking, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring.

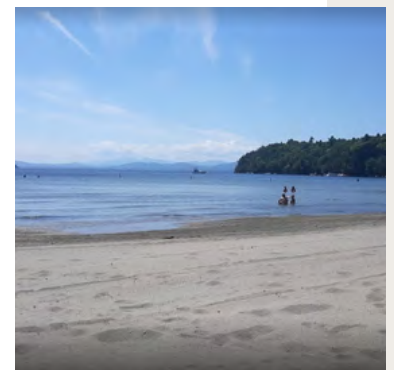

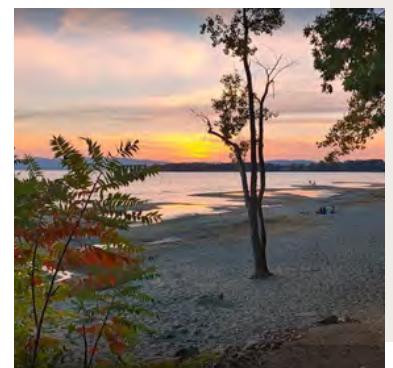
